Carry-on devices Mobility and medical devices don't count toward carry-on limits. If space is limited, the device doesn't fit in the cabin or if it isn't required during the flight, it may need to be checked. These ...

Since some devices use lithium ion batteries, you cannot travel with them in your checked bags. You can travel with them in your carry-on, but you're not allowed to use them on board any flight.

Power banks, e-cigarettes, and other rechargeable devices are banned in all commercial airplane cargo cabins. Check the storage capacity: There is some variation between different carriers' regulations ...

Always carry spare batteries in your carry-on, as checked luggage may increase fire risk. In case of an emergency, know the steps to take if a battery overheats or catches fire. ...

Damage to Tools: Storage in overhead compartments or checked bags can lead to physical damage to battery power tools. Airlines do not guarantee protection for fragile items in ...

Power banks over 160 Wh are banned from both carry-on and checked luggage. When traveling, make sure to keep your battery pack easily accessible. Security personnel may ask to ...

Small lithium batteries, such as those used in phones and laptop computers, can be transported in checked luggage if they are placed in the devices they power. However, replacement ...
